

# **Beadboard Smart Desk**

# Pre-assembly:

- Please read all instructions before starting to assemble.
- Two-person is recommended during assembly..
- Save all packing materials until assembly is complete to avoid accidentally discarding smaller parts or
- An extra wooden knob is included for your convenience.



#### Hardware Included:

A - (4) Wooden knob bolts (4 x 28mm)

B - (4) Wooden knobs

C - (1) Wooden knob with hardware attached






# Parts Included:

D - (2) Desk Pedestal








# **Tools Required:**


(1) Phillips Screwdriver( not included)

#### Assembly:

- For the Pedestals, gently insert Wooden knob with hardware attached (C) into the pre-drilled holes on the front of the sliding breadboard. Attach Wooden Knobs (B) to drawers by holding Wooden Knobs (B) over pre-drilled hole in drawer fronts. Screw Wooden Knob bolts (A) through the rear of the drawer so that it enters the Wooden Knob (B). Tighten using a Phillips Head screwdriver, as shown.
- 2. Repeat for the other drawer and repeat the same steps for the second Pedestal (D).



- 3. Adjust the recessed levelers underneath the Pedestals' legs, if necessary, by turning them.
- 4. Put the two Pedestals (D) in parallel positions and make sure they align with the positioning frames underneath the Desktop (E). Slowly lower the top down until it sits firmly on the pedestals, as shown in the illustration below.
- 5. If necessary, re-adjust the recessed levelers underneath the Pedestals' legs to make sure the whole assembly is balanced.
- 6. Hardware should be checked periodically for tightness.



# **Beadboard Small Desk Hutch**

#### Pre-assembly:

- Please read all instructions before beginning assembly.
- We recommend assembly by two adults.
- Save all packing materials until assembly is complete to avoid accidentally discarding smaller parts or hardware.



#### Hardware Included:

A – Mending Plate- 2pcs (70x40mm)



B – Phillips Head Screws- 8pcs (#6x15mm)




#### **Tools Required:**


Phillips Head Screwdriver (not included). Do not use power drill as it may cause cracking.

## **Assembly Instructions:**

- 7. Place Hutch on a Desk (sold separately); align Hutch and Desk center to center, as shown below. Place Mending Plate (A) at the back of Hutch and Desk. Insert Phillips Head Screws (B) through pre-drilled holes in Mending Plate (A) into predrilled holes at the back of the Hutch; screw another 2 Philips Head Screws (B) through pre-drilled holes in Mending Plate (A) into back side of desk top. Loosely tighten all screws with a Philips Head Screw Driver. Repeat on the other side of Desk for 2<sup>nd</sup> mending plate. Tighten all screws when they are all in place.
- 8. For setting up the Desk, refer to Desk's Assembly Instruction.

9. Hardware should be checked periodically for tightness.



# **Beadboard Large Desk Hutch**

# Pre-assembly:

- Please read all instructions before beginning assembly.
- We recommend assembly by two adults.

- An extra wooden knob is included for your convenience.



#### Hardware Included:

A - (2) Wooden knob bolts (5/32" x 28mm)



B - (2) Wooden knobs




D – (8) Small Phillips head screws (6 x 19mm)


C – (2) Mending plates (70 x 40mm)



E - (2) Brackets








F - (2) Long screws (6 x 32)

G - (2) Short screws (6 x 19)










(1) Phillips Screwdriver (not included)

## Assembly:


- 1. On a soft, scratch-free surface, such as a carpet or rug, remove the hutch from box.
- 2. Using wooden knob hardware pack, carefully attach a Wooden knob (B) to a door, holding the knob over pre-drilled hole in door front. Screw a Wooden knob bolt (A) through the rear of the door so that it enters the Wooden knob (B), using Phillips screwdriver. Tighten and repeat with remaining door.




3. Two adults should lift the hutch up, and carefully place it on the desktop, as shown.



4. Using the Mending plates (C) and Phillips head screws (D), affix the back of the hutch and the desktop. Align the Mending plate over the pre-drilled holes in the hutch, using a Phillips Head Screwdriver, and insert the Phillips Head screws (D) through the Mending plate into the hutch and desk top, tightening with the Phillips Screwdriver. Do not fully tighten until all screws are in place. Failure to do so may cause the parts to misalign. Repeat on other side of hutch and fully tighten all screws. For assembly of the entire desk, please refer to the assembly instruction for the desk.



- 5. Locate a wall stud behind your furniture. Position a Bracket (E) on the stud approximately 1" below the top of the furniture. Mark and drill pilot hole into the center of the stud with a 3/32" drill bit. Attach a Bracket (E) to the stud with the Long Screws (F) provided.
- 6. On the back of the furniture, the second Bracket (E) will need to be attached to the furniture frame at the top. To do this, temporarily move the furniture into its final position and mark the location of the wall's Bracket (E) on the furniture frame with a pencil.
- 7. Move the furniture away from the wall and place a Bracket (E) on the mark. Using the marks from the previous step as a guide, drill holes for screws with a 3/32" drill bit. Attach the bracket to the furniture with the Short Screws (G) provided.
- 8. Move the furniture into its final position, taking care to line up the wall bracket with the furniture bracket. Thread the Nylon Strap (H) through the Bracket as shown in the illustration. Tighten strap until snug. Do not overtighten.
