5. assemble frame




PARTS: A. PANELS B. BRACKETS C. FRAME D. SCREWS E. ANCHORS
F. L-BRACKETS G. SMALL SCREWS H. FOAM PAD




TOOLS: LEVEL, PENCIL, PHILLIPS SCREWDRIVER, AND TAPE MEASURE.

1. Mark bracket positions

The style-tile panels are hung with brackets. Each panel will have one bracket at the top, one at its bottom, and brackets on the sides. We are only showing as an example a 2 x 3 configuration. Please draw the top line according to your configuration.




Draw a level line on the wall. Mark the positions (a, b, c) as shown, for each bracket (16" apart).




Position each bracket along the top line at each point (a, b, c) and use a pencil to mark the wall through each of the two countersunk holes of the bracket, as shown.

2. Install top brackets



Screw a wall anchor into the wall at each pencil mark. To install a wall anchor, use a Phillips head screwdriver to rotate the screw-like anchor into the drywall until it lies flush with the wall surface. It is important that each anchor be installed flush to the wall surface. Use the supplied screws to secure each bracket to the wall at the anchors. Use (2) anchors and (2) screws for each top bracket, as shown.


3. Select and hang panels



Select a panel and position a metal bracket onto the magnets of the back of the panel (at positions B, C, and D). Gently pull each bracket outwardly to straighten them. Peel and stick foam pads at each corner, as shown.


This figure shows how the panels will connect with each other and the order of assembly.

STYLE-TILE SYSTEM WITH FRAME




Each panel measures 16" x 16". Leave an extra 2" around the configuration for the frame.

These instructions are meant as a guide only, and show the basic assembly procedure that can be applied to any configuration you choose.





Hang the panel onto one of the mounted brackets so that the flange of the mounted bracket remains outside the panel, as shown.




Gently pull down on the lower bracket of the newly hung panel. Mark the wall through the right-side countersunk screw hole of the bracket. Slide the bracket about one inch to the left to expose the mark on the wall. Screw in one anchor at this marked location. Reposition the bracket so that the right screw hole of the bracket aligns with the newly installed anchor and use one screw to secure the bracket to the anchor.


4. Continue adding panels



5. Assemble frame



FRAME ASSEMBLY
a) Join the two frame pieces together
b) Position the L-bracket over the corner of the connected frame rails
c) Secure the L-bracket to the frame rails using the provided screws



Position the assembled frame around the wall-mounted panel. Adjust the frame until the magnets engage ("click") against the wall-mounted brackets. Note: each flange of each bracket (shown in the figure of step 3) should fit within an adjacent slot (shown in the figure of step 4) of the frame pieces.
